PETIT JURY FEES SUPPLEMENTAL ATTENDANCE FEE	STANDING ORDER

Pursuant to the Judicial Administration and Technical Amendments Act of 2008, the Jury Selection and Service Act, 28 U.S.C. Subsection 1861, et seq., the Fees, Subsection 1871(b)(2), has been amended to reduce the amount of time after which a petit juror may receive a supplemental daily fee by striking 'thirty days' and inserting 'ten days' effective October 1, 2009.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that petit jurors hearing one case will receive the supplemental fee, not exceeding \$10 more than the attendance fee, for each day of service in excess of ten days required to hear the case. If the attendance fee or the supplemental attendance fee is increased in the future, IT IS ORDERED that petit jurors serving more than 10 days in one case receive the increased amount without issuing a new standing order.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
