By virtue of this order, parties may file such documents under the heading "Other Documents", with the subheading "Sealed Document- filed by statute or leave of court only". The Court may, after further review, unseal the documents if deemed appropriate.

Parties filing documents under seal pursuant to this order have the obligation to provide copies to opposing counsel. Copies should also be provided to the pertinent judge's chambers, in keeping with that judge's filing preferences.
