RE Application Requirements

Attached are the public notice and an application for the position of full-time magistrate judge for the District of South Carolina at Charleston, South Carolina.

The application (original) plus **sixteen (16)** copies must be returned to the Clerk of the District Court; 901 Richland Street; Columbia, South Carolina, 29201, in an envelope marked "Confidential" and must be received by the Clerk of Court no later than 4:00 p.m. on Monday, July 7, 2014.

Attachments to the application are not required, but if an applicant chooses to provide attachments to the application, the attachment(s) should not exceed a total of ten (10) pages.

U.S. DISTRICT COURT FOR THE DISTRICT OF SOUTH CAROLINA

The United States District Court will receive applications for the position of full-time United States Magistrate Judge for the District of South Carolina at Charleston, South Carolina, until Monday, July 7, 2014. The duty station for this position will be in Charleston, so the selected applicant will be required to reside in the Charleston division. The annual salary of a United States Magistrate Judge is \$183,172. The term of office is eight (8) years.

The duties of the position are demanding and wide-ranging and will include: (1) conduct of most preliminary proceedings in criminal cases; (2) trial and disposition of misdemeanor cases; (3) conduct of various pretrial matters and evidentiary proceedings on delegation from the Judges of the District Court; and (4) trial and disposition of civil cases upon consent of the litigants. This position requires extensive research and writing. The basic jurisdiction of the United States Magistrate Judge is specified in 28 U.S.C. § 636.

To be qualified for appointment, an applicant must:

- (1) Be a member in good standing of the bar of the highest court of a State, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, or the Virgin Islands of the United States and have been engaged in the active practice of law for a period of at least five (5) years (with some substitutes authorized);
- (2) Be competent to perform all of the duties of the office, be of good moral character, be emotionally stable and mature, be committed to equal justice under the law, be in good health, be patient and courteous, and be capable of deliberation and decisiveness;
- (3) Be less than seventy (70) years old; and
- (4) Not be related to a Judge of the District Court.

A Merit Selection Panel composed of attorneys and other members of the community will review all applications and will recommend to the Judges of the District Court in confidence the five (5) applicants whom they consider best qualified. The Court will make the appointment following an FBI full-field investigation and IRS tax check of the appointee. An affirmative effort will be made to give due consideration to all qualified candidates.

Applications must be submitted only by the applicant. The original plus sixteen (16) copies of the application must be in an envelope marked "confidential" and must be received no later than 4 p.m., Monday, July 7, 2014.

All applications will be kept confidential, unless the applicant consents to disclosure, and applications will be examined only by members of the Merit Selection Panel and the Judges of the District Court. The Panel's deliberations will remain confidential.
