In addition to federal holidays (Thursday, November 23, 2017, Monday, December 25, 2017, Monday, January 1, 2018), with the approval and at the direction of all the District Judges, the United States District Court for the District of South Carolina shall be closed on the following dates:


Thanksgiving: Wednesday, November 22, 2017
 Friday, November 24, 2017

Christmas: Friday, December 22, 2017
 Tuesday, December 26, 2017

New Year's: Friday, December 29, 2017

During the time that the court is closed that is not deemed a federal holiday, electronic filers must continue to use the electronic case filing system (ECF). Non-electronic filers (party) must observe the procedures outlined in Local Civil Rule 5.02: Filing with the Clerk. The clerk of court is authorized to treat non-electronic filings as "after-hours emergencies" and accept the entire document, or a portion thereof, by having the party fax the document to fax number (803) 765-5960. The party must also subsequently deliver the original document to the office of the clerk of court by 9:30 a.m. on the first day that the court is open following the request. Documents received under this procedure shall be filed as of the date the faxed copy was received by the court.
