On October 6, 2021, the Court amended its April 28, 2021 Standing Order (see No. 3:21 mc-00212-RBH) regarding Social Security Cases so as to extend several of that order's provisions for an additional six months. That extension expires on April 6, 2022. Since the time that the Amended Order was filed, the Court posted for public comment certain proposed new and amended local rules, some of which incorporate the provisions of the Amended Order. The deadline for comments to those proposed new and amended local rules does not occur until after the current expiration of the Amended Order.

Therefore, the Amended Order is further extended for an additional 60 days to provide time for the court to consider any comments to the proposed new and amended local rules and to take further action to adopt the proposed new and amended local rules or consider further extension of this order if necessary.
