The current terms of the office of the following United States Magistrate Judges are due to expire as set forth below:

Kevin F. McDonald . . . . .	term expires May 31, 2018

The United States District Court is required to establish a panel of citizens to consider the reappointment of these magistrate judges to a new term.

The magistrate judge, among other duties, conducts most preliminary proceedings in criminal cases, tries and disposes of misdemeanors, conducts various pretrial and evidentiary proceedings on delegation from district court judges, and tries and disposes of civil cases upon consent of the litigants.

Comments are invited from the public and the Bar members on whether Magistrate Judges Hodges, Rogers, and McDonald should be recommended for reappointment. Written comments must be submitted by Monday, December 4, 2017, in an envelope marked personal and confidential to the following:
