Whereas, the entire Florence division will be undergoing complete relocation of its I.T. infrastructure causing disruption to all court operations in that division during July 4 and July 5, 2019, it is therefore ordered:

The District Court for the District of South Carolina shall be closed on Friday, July 5, 2019, which will be treated the same as a federal holiday for the purpose of computing any period of time prescribed by the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the Local Rules, or any applicable statute.
