Rule 30(b)(6) Marketing Deposition of Pfizer

- Pfizer's motion to quash Plaintiffs' April 8, 2015 Notice of Rule 30(b)(6) Deposition (Dkt. No. 855) is DENIED. However, the Court imposes certain limitations on this deposition.
- 2. First, the parties are ordered to meet and confer about the production of documents that may obviate the need for a deposition on particular topics. Plaintiffs have represented to the Court in briefing and at the April 23, 2015 Status Conference that, based on previous productions, they no longer seek testimony on Notice Topics 1 and 2. The parties are directed to continue to confer in this manner and to narrow the topics on which testimony is necessary as much as possible.
- 3. Second, this Rule 30(b)(6) deposition will take place after the fact depositions of sales representatives but on or before July 17, 2015. After the sales representatives' depositions, the parties are to confer on whether and to what extent these depositions narrow the topics on which testimony is necessary from a 30(b)(6) witness.

Future Status Conferences

- 4. The May Status Conference is set for May 21, 2015 at 10 A.M. (See CMO 18, Dkt. No. 499.)
- 5. Status Conferences will also be held on the following dates at 10 A.M.:
 - a. June 18, 2015;
 - b. July 23, 2015;

 - d. September 24, 2015.
