A magistrate judge, among other duties, conducts most preliminary proceedings in criminal cases, tries and disposes of misdemeanor cases, conducts various pretrial and evidentiary proceedings on delegation from district court judges, and tries and disposes of civil cases upon consent of the litigants.

The current terms of office of the following United States Magistrate Judges are due to expire as set forth below:

Thomas E. Rogers, III at Florence, South Carolina - term expires May 7, 2026

Kevin F. McDonald at Greenville, South Carolina - term expires May 31, 2026

Shiva V. Hodges at Columbia, South Carolina - term expires June 7, 2026

The United States District Court is required by law to establish a panel of citizens (Merit Selection Panel) to consider the reappointment of each of these United States Magistrate Judges to a new eight-year term.

Comments are invited from members of the Bar and the public as to whether United States Magistrate Judges Rogers, McDonald, and Hodges should be recommended by the Merit Selection Panel for reappointment by the Court.
